

# LILT POSTER CONTEST

The LILT Poster Contest celebrates National Foreign Language Week, which takes place in March of each year.

In order for you and your students to participate in this contest you must be a LILT member whose dues were paid by Febaurary 15<sup>th</sup> of the current, contest year, or a member of an AAT which is a LILT Association Member for the contest year as listed on the home page, WWW.LILTFL.ORG. These are the steps you must take:

## STEP 1: ANNOUNCEMENT OF THE LILT POSTER CONTEST TOPIC

Read the announcement with the current year's topic and the due date for mailing. This can be found on LILT's website under *LILT Poster Contest* (right column).

Please remember your LILT membership dues must be paid by February 15<sup>th</sup> of the current, contest year in order for your students to be eligible to participate, or a member of an AAT which is a LILT Association Member for the contest year as listed on the home page, WWW.LILTFL.ORG.

## STEP 2: TEACHER AND STUDENT DIRECTIONS

*Directions for Teachers:* Make sure you, the current, classroom teacher, have read the directions for what you must do to have your students produce a winning entry.

Directions for Students: Your students must also follow their directions in order to create a winning entry. Not following the directions carefully will disquality the student's work.



## STEP 3: DROP-OFF LOCATIONS

When each teacher has selected his or her best current, classroom students' entries for competition, they are to be dropped off at one of the drop-off locations which is listed on LILT's website (WWW.LILTFL.ORG) under LILT Poster Contest (left column).

#### STEP 4: SUBMISSION FORMS

Please complete the Submissions Forms in DUPLICATE, completing them entirely, and printing so they may be easily read.

#### STEP 5: LILT POSTER CONTEST CHECKOFF LIST

To make sure you, the current, classroom teacher, have not forgotten anything in completing your submissions, kindly use the Checkoff List to double check all of the above steps, ensuring you'll submit viable entries. *Enclose a completed Checkoff List inside each package you submit.*

CATEGORIES: Category A: Grades 4-6

Category B: Grades 7-9 Category C: Grades 10-12

EVERY TEACHER SHOULD ENSURE THAT ONLY POSTERS THAT MEET THE FOLLOWING RULES ARE SUBMITTED TO AVOID DISQUALIFICATION.

#### Directions for Teachers:

- 1. Submit only a maximum of **5** posters per category, per school.
- 2. Submit **ONE** flat, neatly wrapped package of a maximum of 5 posters for each category.
- 3. Print from the LILT website the LILT Poster Contest Checkoff List and 2 copies of the Submission Form.
- 4. Include a copy of **BOTH** the Submission Form and Checkoff List inside **EACH** package.
- 5. Attach **ONE** completed Submission Form to the outside of **EACH** package.
- 6. LILT members: affix a copy of your membership card or the address label of a LILT mailing to the outside of the package.
- 7. AAT Memberships will be confirmed by your AAT

## **Directions for Students:**

- 1. Each entry must bear only one student's name.
- 2. Only posters on 18" x 24" **oak tag** of any color in "portrait" orientation **→ → →** are acceptable.
- 3. Artistic media: **only** felt tips, watercolors, oil or acrylic paints, pastels, colored pencils, Crayons™ or collages
- 4. The use of computer for graphics, lettering or designs is not permitted, nor are 3-D effects.
- 5. All work must be original. Figures, slogans, etc. protected by copyright are not permitted.
- 6. The LILT Poster Contest Theme must appear in **English** on the poster. In addition, other languages may be used. **Any orthographic and/or grammatical errors will disqualify the entry.**
- 7. Include the following information **ONLY** on the **BACK** of the poster:
  - · student's name and grade
  - · current, classroom teacher's name
  - school name and address
