



STUDENT WORLD LANGUAGE COMPETITION GUIDELINES  
REGISTRATION DEADLINE – MARCH 1<sup>ST</sup>

**INTERNATIONAL DANCE VIDEO**

**TOPIC:** There is no specific topic. All types of dance are acceptable that are part of the culture of the target language being studied and must be in good taste.

1. A brief introduction in English, which explains the cultural significance of the dance, **MUST** precede the dance, **NOT TO EXCEED TWO (2) MINUTES**.
2. No presentation (introduction and dance) may exceed **SIX (6) MINUTES**.
3. The dance must have cultural significance to the target language currently being studied.
4. **Students may perform in only one dance competition.**
5. Only ten (10) students maximum may perform in one (1) dance.
6. All video submissions must be submitted as links to a YouTube video. Record a student or group of students performing in the target language, upload the video to YouTube (**as an Unlisted Video**).

Your LILT membership must have been paid before **FEBRUARY 15<sup>TH</sup>** if your students are to participate in LILT's competitions. You may consult the LILT Treasurer Treasurer, Ann Marie Lombardi, [treasurer@liltfl.org](mailto:treasurer@liltfl.org), to confirm your membership.
