



STUDENT WORLD LANGUAGE COMPETITION INFORMATION & GUIDELINES

REGISTRATION AND PAYMENT DEADLINE: **MARCH 1st**

MEMBERSHIP: You must be a current paid-up member of LILT by **FEBRUARY 15TH** of the current year in order to enter your students. If you are in doubt, consult the Treasurer, Ann Marie Lombardi, treasurer@liltfl.org.

PAYMENT: **COMPETITION FEE: \$10 PER TEACHER, UP TO FIVE ENTRIES TOTAL FOR THE COMPETITION OR \$15 PER TEACHER, UP TO TEN ENTRIES TOTAL FOR THE COMPETITION. ALL FEES ARE NONREFUNDABLE.** All payments must be submitted online.

CHECK OFF LIST: For your convenience, please look over the Student World Language Competition Checkoff List and be sure to have all of the necessary information for registration.

ONLINE SUBMISSION FORM: Be sure to complete the Online Submission Form in its entirety.

SUBMISSIONS: All written submissions should be uploaded to the submission form as a PDF. All video submissions must be submitted as links to a YouTube video. Record a student or group of students performing in the target language, upload the video to YouTube (**as an *Unlisted Video***) and complete the student entry form. It's that simple!! Have fun and enjoy the process! A parental consent form must be filled out for each student in a video entry, which can be found on the LILT website.

NATIVE / HERITAGE SPEAKERS: All native / heritage speakers must be registered in the native speaker category. If not, they will be disqualified. Combinations of native speakers with non-native speakers in groups are not allowed. The judge's decision on native or heritage proficiency **WILL BE FINAL AND BINDING.**

WINNING MEDALS/RIBBONS PICKUP: The teacher of winning students will be given a date, time, and place to pick up winners' medals and certificates. After that date, all unclaimed winning medals and certificates will become the property of LILT and will not be forwarded, mailed or delivered.

1st Place, 2nd Place, 3rd Place, and Honorable Mention medals will be awarded in each category, as well as a "Best of" video for the submitting teacher.
