Directions:

- Submitting teacher must be a current member of LILT
- Teacher registration fee \$10 for up to 5 entries / \$15 for 6 10 entries (maximum)
- All entries will be submitted online
- Some teacher corrections prior to submission allowed
- No foreign words permitted. This includes all foreign brand names, names of stores, places, etc.
- Everything must be in English.
- No graphics are allowed.
- No student may submit more than one essay.
- Deadline to register and submit *Friday, March 6, 2020*

All written submissions should be uploaded to the submission form as a PDF.

- o B Middle School/Junior High
- o C High School

*Each division will be divided into the following 3 levels:

- Entering: 100 or less words
- Emerging and Transitioning: 250 or less words
- Expanding and Commanding: 500 or less words
