

STUDENT WORLD LANGUAGE COMPETITION GUIDELINES REGISTRATION DEADLINE – MARCH 6TH WRITTEN ORIGINAL ESSAY Theme: Meal Taking / Food and Drink / Holidays and Celebrations

1. The essay must be an original composition with the following word limitations:

GRADES K - 5	Maximum of 20 words
ALL LEVEL 1 AND 2	30 - 80 word maximum
ALL LEVEL 3 AND 4	100 - 200 word maximum
COLLEGE / IB / AP	200 - 400 word maximum

2. All work must be original and appropriate to the level being studied with some teacher corrections prior to submission and in the target language. All accents must be included.

3. No English permitted. This includes all English brand names, names of stores, places, etc. **EVERYTHING** must be in the target language.

4. NO GRAPHICS ARE ALLOWED.

- 5. No student may submit more than one (1) essay.
- 6. A copy of the original essay must be uploaded to the submission form as a PDF.
