Grades K - 5 = 5 lines All level 1 and 2 = 6 - 8 lines All level 3 and 4 = 8 - 10 lines College / IB / AP = 10 - 15 lines

- 5. Haiku is not permitted.
- 6. NO GRAPHICS ARE ALLOWED.
- 7. A copy of the original poem must be uploaded to the submission form as a PDF.
