

## STUDENT WORLD LANGUAGE COMPETITION GUIDELINES REGISTRATION DEADLINE – MARCH 6<sup>TH</sup> POETRY RECITATION VIDEO / ASL POETRY INTERPRETATION VIDEO

Topic: There is no specific topic. All subjects for poetry recitation or interpretation are acceptable and must be in good taste.

- 1. A student **MUST MEMORIZE** a published poetry selection of an author, written in the target language in which he/she is currently enrolled, or in English for an ASL interpretation video. **ORIGINAL STUDENT POEMS ARE NOT ACCEPTABLE.**
- 2. The title and the author of the poem must be mentioned in the video. <u>Teachers must upload a copy of the poem in the registration form.</u>
- 3. Each video recitation or poem interpretation must adhere to a **three-minute** time limit.
- 4. No students may share in the recitation of a single poem.
- 5. All video submissions must be submitted as links to a YouTube video. Record a student or group of students performing in the target language, upload the video to YouTube (**as an Unlisted Video**).

You must be a current LILT member (2020) if your students are to participate in any LILT competition. You may consult the LILT Treasurer, Ann Marie Lombardi, <a href="mailto:treasurer@liltfl.org">treasurer@liltfl.org</a> to confirm your membership.
