

STUDENT WORLD LANGUAGE COMPETITION GUIDELINES
REGISTRATION DEADLINE – MARCH 15TH
INTERNATIONAL DANCE VIDEO

TOPIC: There is no specific topic. All types of dance are acceptable that are part of the culture of the target language being studied and must be in good taste.

1. A brief introduction in English, which explains the cultural significance of the dance, **MUST** precede the dance, **NOT TO EXCEED TWO (2) MINUTES**.
2. No presentation (introduction and dance) may exceed **SIX (6) MINUTES**.
3. The dance must have cultural significance to the target language currently being studied.
4. **Students may perform in only one dance competition.**
5. Only ten (10) students maximum may perform in one (1) dance.
6. All video submissions must be submitted as links to a YouTube video. Record a student or group of students performing a traditional dance and upload the video to YouTube (*as an Unlisted Video*).

You must be a current LILT member (2021) if your students are to participate in any LILT competition. You may consult the LILT Treasurer Treasurer, Ann Marie Lombardi, treasurer@liltfl.org, to confirm your membership.

COMPETITION FEE:
