The Lucille DiPietro Lambert LILT Student Award For Excellence in World Language Studies on Long Island of five hundred dollars (\$500) is presented to outstanding graduating seniors whose teachers are able to acknowledge fine language achievement by nominating their top language student(s). Each school may nominate more than one June graduate.

TO APPLY:

The nominating teacher must submit all of the following:

1. Nominating Recommendation: The teacher's formal letter of recommendation on school letterhead
2. Second Teacher Recommendation: Letter of recommendation on school letterhead from a World Language teacher (If there is no World Language teacher, a letter of recommendation on school letterhead from another teacher may be substituted. This teacher must have taught the nominated student.)
3. School World Language Profile Sheet
4. Extra-curricular World Language Activity Evaluation: advisor evaluation(s)
5. Candidate World Language Study Profile
6. Official Student Transcript
7. Candidate's Statement: required attestations and signature

REQUIREMENTS:

- The nominating teacher must be a current member of LILT.
- The nominating teacher must have taught the student.
- The nominated student must be currently enrolled in a World Language class.
- Receipt of this award is dependent on the submission to LILT of a completed IRS W-9 form.

The Student Award winner will be announced at the LILT Spring General Membership Meeting in early June.
