



STUDENT WORLD LANGUAGE COMPETITION GUIDELINES

REGISTRATION POSTMARK DEADLINE - MARCH 1st

MULTI-MEDIA COMPUTER PROGRAM

TOPIC: CONSULT THE TOPIC SHEET FOUND ELSEWHERE ON THIS WEBSITE'S HOMEPAGE.

1. All entries must be original productions by **ONE** student programmer appropriate to the level in which the student is enrolled, and prepared and narrated in the target language by the student programmer. A student can submit only one entry. Prizes are awarded only to student programmers.
2. **FORMAT:** An integrated multi-media computer program executed on a **CD ONLY** which includes:
 - **oral and written expression** on the topic **ONLY** in the target language. Entries containing any English will be eliminated from the competition. This includes all English brand names, names of stores, places, etc.;
 - scanned/digital photo and/or video clips appropriate to the topic;
 - execution using Power Point (K-12). No other software program will be accepted.
 - PC format ONLY is acceptable.
3. A **Cue Card** **MUST** be **1 MINUTE** in length at the beginning of each program without use of the stop button. It must contain the following information:
 - title of presentation in the target language
 - category of competition
 - name of school
 - name of teacher
 - school phone number
 - date of production
 - **NAME OF STUDENT PROGRAMMER/NARRATOR** who created this multi-media computer program
 - Write the following verbatim: "I am the sole student who created this multi-media computer program."
 - software program and version used
4. **LENGTH:** No entry can exceed six (6) minutes in time execution at normal speed (a five (5) minute program plus one (1) minute for the cue card). **Every card MUST have a stop button to be used by the judges when necessary.**

Division A (K-6): A minimum of 6 and a maximum of 8 cards, including the cue card and the title page.

Division B (7-9): A minimum of 8 and a maximum of 12 cards, including the cue card and the title page.

Division C: (10-12) A minimum of 12 and a maximum of 16 cards, including the cue card and the title page.

5. All oral recordings should be clear, and the volume of the spoken dialogue should be loud and clear. Students should speak slowly and enunciate clearly, giving the language's accent its proper due.
6. The student programmers must be currently enrolled in your foreign language class. You may not enter students from previous years if they are not enrolled in your class this year.
7. A registration fee must be paid for each student.
8. **There can be no more than three (3) entries per language/per level/per division/ per school/per teacher.**
9. **There can only be one multi-media computer program per CD.**
10. Each CD jewel box must have taped or pasted on each front cover an **OFFICIAL TITLE COVER LABEL FOR EACH SEPARATE MULTI-MEDIA COMPUTER PROGRAM**. Duplicate as needed.
11. Make sure each CD itself has a pasted CD label with the teacher's name, school, language, level and division or on each CD itself using a Sharpie™ marker, print the teacher's last name and the words: "multi-media" (see # 10 -12 below). Do not use tape since it will damage the computer drive. (See # 9)
12. **EACH CD MUST CONTAIN ONLY ONE PRESENTATION OF ONLY ONE LANGUAGE, ONE LEVEL, ONE DIVISION (i.e. FRENCH, LEVEL 1, DIVISION B).**
13. **EACH MULTI-MEDIA COMPUTER PROGRAM MUST HAVE ITS OWN OFFICIAL MULTI-MEDIA COMPUTER PROGRAM REGISTRATION SHEET SUBMITTED WITH EACH MULTI-MEDIA COMPUTER PROGRAM. YOU MUST COMPLETE ONE REGISTRATION SHEET FOR EACH MULTI-MEDIA COMPUTER PROGRAM SUBMITTED. (THERE IS ONLY ONE MULTI-MEDIA COMPUTER PROGRAM PER CD.)**
14. Some teacher correction is allowed.

POSTMARK REGISTRATION DATE: MARCH 1st

ALL MANILA ENVELOPES, CONTAINING REGISTRATION MATERIALS, ENTRIES, AND YOUR CHECK, MUST BEAR A UNITED STATES POSTMARK OF NO LATER THAN MARCH 1st.

Your LILT membership must have been paid before **FEBRUARY 15TH** if your students are to participate in LILT's competitions. You may consult the LILT Treasurer via the Executive Board listing found elsewhere on the LILT Website Homepage.

B - Grades 7 - 9
C - Grades 10 - 12

LEVELS:
1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 - correspond to current placement/ years of study
1N, 2N, 3N, 4N, 5N, 6N - native speaker or near-native speaker

COMPETITION FEE: \$7.00 PER STUDENT AND IS GOOD FOR MULTIPLE CATEGORIES OF COMPETITION. ALL FEES ARE NONREFUNDABLE.

SUBMIT YOUR REGISTRATION FORM AND ENTRIES WITH A PERSONAL CHECK, BANK CHECK, SCHOOL CHECK OR POSTAL MONEY ORDER POSTMARKED BY MARCH 1st TO THE PERSON NAMED ON THE TOPIC SHEET FOUND ELSEWHERE ON THE LILT WEBSITE HOMEPAGE.
