



STUDENT WORLD LANGUAGE COMPETITION GUIDELINES

REGISTRATION POSTMARK DEADLINE - MARCH 1st

WRITTEN ORIGINAL POETRY

Topic: *There is no specific topic. All subjects for original poetry are acceptable and they must be in good taste.*

1. All work must be original and appropriate to the level being studied with some teacher correction allowed prior to submission of the final copy. All accents **MUST** be included.
2. Each entry must be typed and include a **SEPARATE, STAPLED OFFICIAL LILT COVER PAGE**; duplicate as needed.
3. **No student identification of any kind may appear on the poem itself, front or back.**
4. No English is permitted. This includes all English brand names, names of stores, places, etc. **EVERYTHING** must be in the target language.
5. **There can be no more than eight (8) entries per language/per level/per division/per school/per teacher.**
6. **No student may submit more than one (1) original poem.**
7. **Original poems must have the following minimal number of lines: Levels I and II = 8 lines, Level III = 12 lines, Levels IV-VI = 16 lines.**
8. Haiku is not permitted.
9. All poems must be typed on plain white letter-size paper (8.5" x 11"). **NO GRAPHICS ARE ALLOWED.**
10. **EACH ORIGINAL POEM WITH ITS OWN STAPLED OFFICIAL LILT POETRY COVER SHEET MUST BE PLACED IN A FILE FOLDER (9" X 11.75" - standard letter size).**

POSTMARK REGISTRATION DATE: MARCH 1st

ALL MANILA ENVELOPES, CONTAINING REGISTRATION MATERIALS, ENTRIES, AND YOUR CHECK, MUST BEAR A UNITED STATES POSTMARK OF NO LATER THAN MARCH 1st.

 B - Grades 7 - 9
 C - Grades 10 - 12

LEVELS: 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 - correspond to current placement/ years of study
 1N , 2N, 3N, 4N, 5N, 6N - native speaker or near-native speaker

COMPETITION FEE: \$7.00 PER STUDENT AND IS GOOD FOR MULTIPLE CATEGORIES OF COMPETITION. ALL FEES ARE NONREFUNDABLE.

SUBMIT YOUR REGISTRATION FORM AND ENTRIES WITH A PERSONAL CHECK, BANK CHECK, SCHOOL CHECK OR POSTAL MONEY ORDER POSTMARKED BY MARCH 1ST TO TO THE PERSON NAMED ON THE TOPIC SHEET FOUND ELSEWHERE ON THE LILT WEBSITE.

BEFORE SUBMITTING THEM FOR COMPETITION.**
